COMING EVENTS

June 3 Carderock, Md.

June 9-10 Lomore Cave, Lomore, V. Va., and another cave, to be selected later.
Individual commissary and camping at or in the entrance to a large mine.

To reach cave, drive west from Clifton Forge on U.S. 60 to the vicinity of Lomore, Va. Turn south on Va. Route 616 (road leads to Richpatch and Strom). Large mine entrance can be seen on the west side of the valley a few hundred yards south of U.S. 60.

Camp will be in the vicinity of the mine entrance (inside if raining). Plan to leave mine entrance at 10:00 A.M. Saturday for the first cave, entrance to which is on the hill above the mine. Trip will be led by Ted Schad.

Each participant should have at least two sources of light to take into the cave.

Camping conditions at the mine are uncertain and may involve fording the stream, therefore it may be advisable to sleep Friday night at a picnic area which is shown on some road maps on U.S. 60 between Lexington and Clifton Forge, or elsewhere.

June 17 Great Falls, Md., followed by meeting at Chris Scoredos' at 6804 32nd Street, N.W. If you tell them to expect you (call Mrs. Scoredos at WO 6-2843), they'll have enough supper for you.
